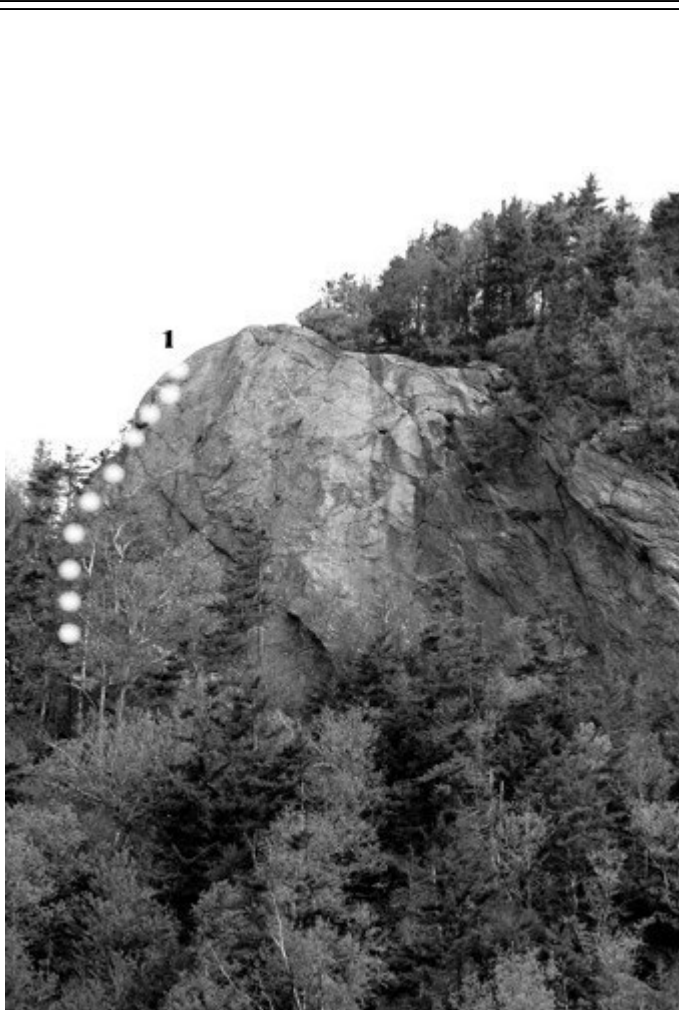


Deer's Leap - Vermont

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1. Off Width***



Difficulty: 5.6 ***

Protection: G

Description: Great moderate climb topped by a large flake with a wide crack on its right side. Start at the left of the cliff by a broken off block. Climb a steep crack past several triangular pockets to an alcove. Climb up and right on easy, unprotected face to the flake or the crack with good gear, then turn right to the flake. Layback the flake, then the wide crack and summit with a baley on the top left of the cliff. Excellent beginner's lead.
