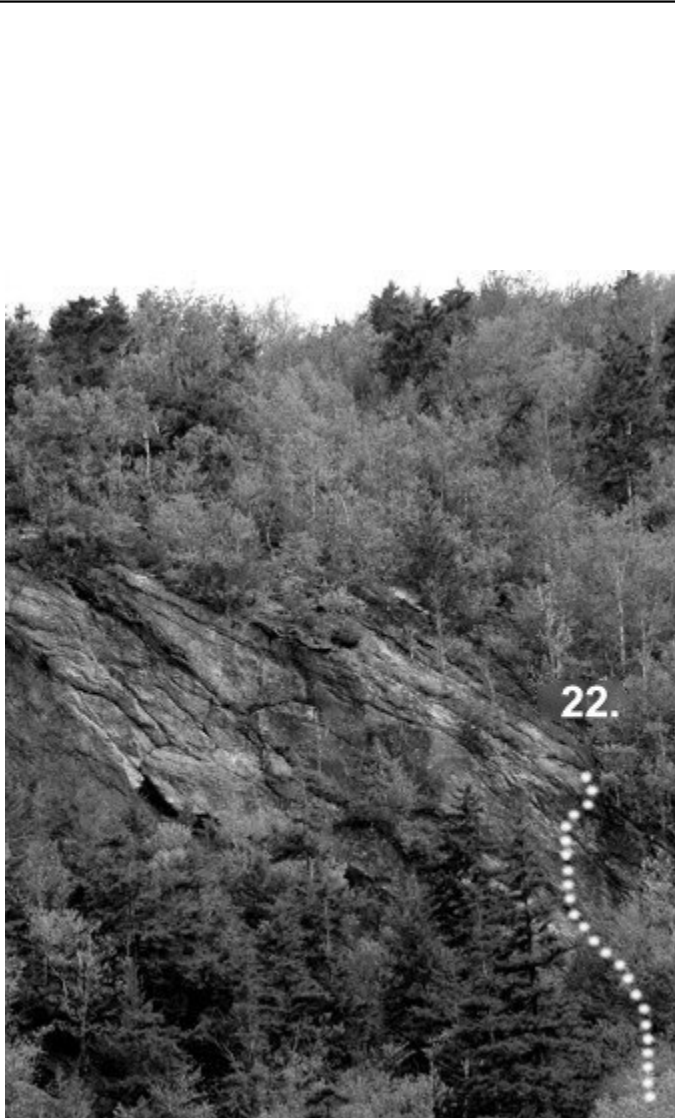

22. Flat Vision **



Difficulty: 5.10c

Protection: G - 5 bolts, knifeblad #2 cam, alines, ring anchors.

Description: Just past the right e of the cave is a steep, bolted face. Climb the face past 3 bolts (steep than it looks - hence the name) p easier ground to a 4th bolt. Finish nice clean and steep face past a 5 bolt (and an alien if necessary) to anchors.

The crux start is a total reach mov so it will be easier for tall climbers great ape indexes. If you can reach the finger pocket from the ground only 10c. If you have to do a mov two to the pocket, it is probably n 11'ish.

The 4th bolt was drilled from a #2 micro that blew seconds after Nick finally got the bolt cranked down i clipped. Woohee!

First Free Ascent: Isa Oehry and Nick Goldsmith (two shorties) 07-03. Left hand finish was addes 08-03.
